Section 1.


The sums set forth in Section one, for the several purposes set forth therein and subject to the conditions set forth in sections four through twelve of Barnstable County Ordinance 06-07, are hereby transferred, pursuant to Section seven of Barnstable County Ordinance 06-07, from the County Appropriation Reserve Fund (Budget 4011) to the designated budget group as transferred appropriations for Barnstable County for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, two thousand and seven.


