BARNSTABLE COUNTY

Ordinance 90 - 4

To authorize the County to borrow money to pay for necessary repairs in the first district courthouse in the town of Barnstable.

Barnstable County hereby ordains:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners is hereby authorized to repair and/or replace the roofing on the fourth level of the first district courthouse in the town of Barnstable

Section 2. For the purposes set forth in section one, the County Treasurer, with the approval of the County Commissioners, may borrow from time to time, on the credit of the County, such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, fifty thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the County therefor, which shall bear on their face the words, Barnstable County First District Courthouse Loan, County Ordinance of 1990. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such loans shall be payable in not more than ten years from their dates. Such bonds or notes shall be signed by the County Treasurer and countersigned by a majority of the County Commissioners. The County may sell securities at public or private sale upon such terms and conditions as the County Commissioners may deem proper but not for less than their par value. Indebtedness incurred under this ordinance shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the Massachusetts General Laws.
