Resolution 03-05

WHEREAS, The Army Corps of Engineers is reviewing the request of private developers to construct 130 electricity-generating wind turbines in Nantucket Sound;

WHEREAS, Local communities and state and federal governments should be able to promulgate sensible regulations protecting our coastal resources; and

WHEREAS, The Assembly of Delegates is concerned about the regional environmental and economic impacts of industrial activity in nantucket Sound.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Assembly of Delegates:

The Assembly of Delegates requests the Army Corps of Engineers to not issue a permit for any development in the federal waters of Nantucket Sound until local communities and the state and federal governments promulgate sensible regulations, including zoning, of our coastal public resources.

The foregoing Resolution was adopted by the Barnstable County Assembly of Delegates by a roll call vote with 86.09% voting yes, 8.09% voting no and 91.92% of Barnstable County Delegates present and voting at a regular meeting held on November 5, 2003.
