To provide for the reimbursement of expenses of Delegates and the Clerk and for authorization for payment of expenditures for the Assembly of Delegates.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Barnstable County Assembly of Delegates:

Section 1. Delegates and the Clerk of the Assembly of Delegates shall be reimbursed for their auto-travel-mileage expenses incurred for the purposes of attending meetings of the Assembly or its committees or for the conduct of other business of, or performance of work for, the Assembly or its committees, and for their other expenses incurred in travelling in performance of their official duties.

Section 2. The Speaker of the Assembly of Delegates, or his designee, is authorized to approve for payment or reimbursement by the County Treasurer any and all expenditures properly and reasonably incurred or made for the operations of the Assembly of Delegates and its committees, or for the conduct of other business of or performance of work for the Assembly or its committees, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the expenses described in section one of this resolution.
