Resolution 93-3

To amend Resolution 91-2, which established the Standing Committee on Finance, by changing the number of members from five to a minimum of three members with a maximum of five members, as determined by the Speaker, and to increase the responsibilities of the committee by adding duties performed by the former Standing Committee on the Assembly Budget.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Barnstable County Assembly of Delegates:

A Standing Committee on Finance be established to consist of a minimum of three members and a maximum of five members, as appointed by the Speaker, to address all matters relating to the Assembly's Budget, County fiscal policies and procedures, including appropriations, budgeting, borrowing, finances, funds, revenues from fees, taxes and other sources, and inter-governmental fiscal policies and procedures, to conduct public hearings and report to the Assembly from time to time on all proposed appropriations, ordinances and other matters assigned to it.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by unanimous vote of the Barnstable County Assembly of Delegates, with Delegates representing 98.09% of the population of Barnstable County present and voting at a meeting held February 3, 1993.
