
BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Barnstable County Assembly of Delegates:

A Standing Committee on Natural Resources, to consist of a minimum of three members and a maximum of five members, as appointed by the Speaker, to address County activities relating to environmental matters, to conduct public hearings and to report to the Assembly from time to time on matters assigned to it.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by unanimous vote of the Barnstable County Assembly of Delegates, with Delegates representing 98.09% of the population of Barnstable County present and voting at a meeting held February 3, 1993.
