

BARNSTABLE COUNTY ASSEMBLY OF DELEGATES

In the Year Nineteen Hundred and Ninety-Three

Resolution 93-16

To promote, encourage and assist in the development of a greenbelt walkway across Cape Cod.

WHEREAS, There has been a significant amount of land preserved as open space on Cape Cod;

WHEREAS, The open space areas are often not connected and in many cases there is inadequate public access;

WHEREAS, Town funds necessary to acquire additional open space or provide access are limited;

WHEREAS, There are undeveloped greenbelt areas that could potentially provide linkages;

WHEREAS, A map has been developed that indicates that a walking trail could be created on Cape Cod;

WHEREAS, Barnstable County recognizes the importance of maintaining community character for a healthy economic environment;

WHEREAS, Governor Weld is proposing an open space bond that could potentially help fund this type of project.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, the Barnstable County Assembly of Delegates:


Enthusiastically endorses the concept initiated by the Board of County Commissioners to promote, encourage and assist in the development of a greenbelt walkway across Cape Cod.

Will participate in a working group of people from the public and private sector and work with the State delegation to draft appropriate legislation.
