WHEREAS, The Cape Cod Technology Council, Inc.'s mission is to foster the growth of technology-based businesses on Cape Cod, a clean industry with high and stable wages and with year-round employment and short commutes; and to develop this industry on Cape Cod using Cape Cod businesses, building from within when possible;
