Resolution 99-5

To request that the County Commissioners determine that Delegates of the Assembly are employees by definition under Chapter 32B, M.G.L., and are eligible employees for Heath Insurance benefits as provided for within the County for its employees.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Barnstable County Assembly of Delegates:

Chapter 32B, Section 2, Definitions, states, in part, that an employee is a person appointed or elected by popular vote. The definition further states that "persons elected by popular vote may be considered eligible employees during the entire term for which they are elected regardless of the number of hours devoted to the service of the governmental unit".

Therefore, Delegates of the Assembly, elected by popular vote, request that the Board of County Commissioners consider that Delegates are eligible employees for Health Insurance benefits during the entire term of which they are elected.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Barnstable County Assembly of Delegates, with Delegates representing 68.22% of the population of Barnstable County present and voting, with 46.28% voting yes and 36.92% voting no at a meeting held on March 3, 1999.
