### HUD Annual Point in Time Count of the Homeless - January 24, 2023

Data is based on an unduplicated count. **Unsheltered** persons must meet the HUD definition - residing in a place not meant for human habitation, such as cars, parks, encampments, abandoned buildings, or on the street. Those **in shelter** are either residing in Emergency Shelter or residing in a motel or hospitality setting paid for by an organization. **Transitional Housing** is meant to be temporary with a two-year limit.
