DONATE YOUR EXCESS FOOD TO END HUNGER AND FOOD WASTE IN YOUR COMMUNITY.

Barnstable County Government's Cape Cod Cooperative Extension and Food Rescue US are teaming up to reduce both hunger and food waste by establishing a group of dedicated volunteer food rescuers that deliver food to food insecure individuals and families in Barnstable County. The program is looking for local food providers to become food donors, ensuring their excess food goes to those who need it most.

WHO CAN BE A FOOD DONOR?

Any business that has excess food that could be going to waste can connect with their local Food Rescue US location and discuss donating their food. These businesses can include:

Grocery Stores | Restaurants | Farms | Farmers Markets
Hotels | Hospitals

The program will match the donated food to a social service agency in the community that can best utilize it. A volunteer rescuer will select a time that's convenient for them to pick-up and drop-off the excess food. It's as easy as that!
