HUD Annual Point-in-Time Count of the Homeless - January 24, 2017

Data is based on an unduplicated count. Unsheltered persons meets the HUD definition - residing in a place not meant for human habitation, such as cars, parks sidewalks, abandoned building or on the street or at risk of being evicted within two weeks and has no place to go. Those in shelter are either residing in Emergency Shelter or residing in a motel or hospitality setting paid for by an organization. Transitional Housing is meant to be temporary with a two year limit.
