

**Cape and Islands Regional Network to Address Homelessness  
 HUD Annual Point-in-Time Count of the Homeless – Final Data**

**January 27, 2016**

This data is based on an Unduplicated Count. Unsheltered persons fit the HUD definition - residing in a place not meant for human habitation, such as cars, parks sidewalks, abandoned building or on the street. Those in shelter are either residing in Emergency Shelter or residing in a motel or hospitality setting paid for by an organization. Transitional Housing is meant to be temporary with a two year limit.
