Notice of Public Hearings
Barnstable County Proposed Ordinance Nos. 22-19 and 22-20

On July 20, 2022 at 4:00 p.m., the Barnstable County Assembly of Delegates will hold hybrid, (in person and virtual) public hearings on Proposed Ordinance 22-19, to authorize the Board of Commissioners to approve operating budget transfers in the amount of \$39,400.00 for salaries, fringe benefits and supplies in accordance with Cape Cod regional government Home Rule Charter, Section 2 – 8, item (d) (iii), and Proposed Ordinance 22-20, To transfer to a special revenue fund by making supplemental appropriations fiscal year two thousand twenty-three in the amount of \$2,500,000 to fund the Regional Freshwater Initiative Program. The public hearings will be held in the Mary Pat Flynn Conference Center, Barnstable County Complex, 3195 Main Street Route 6A, Barnstable, MA. The public hearings will be open to anyone wishing to testify or make public comment on the proposed ordinances.
