
At a regular meeting of the Barnstable County Board of Regional Commissioners, on the tenth day of August, A.D. 2022, held in the Mary Pat Flynn Conference Room, motion by Commissioner Forest to authorize Ordinance 22-18, to allocate the amount of \$5,000,000 from funds received by Barnstable County under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to be expended on competitive grants for small and medium-sized projects, 2nd by Commissioner Bergstrom was approved by a vote of 3-0-0.

BARNSTABLE COUNTY
In the Year Two Thousand Twenty-Two
Ordinance 22-18

“The Cape Cod regional government, known as Barnstable county, hereby ordains;

Section 1.


The sum of \$5,000,000 shall be made available from funds received by Barnstable County under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) for grants to non-profit organizations, private/for profit organizations, cities, towns, villages, or other non-county local governmental units; provided, that \$2,000,000 shall be made available for grants between \$100,000 and \$250,000 to fund small-sized projects; provided further, that \$3,000,000 shall be made available for grants between \$250,000 and \$500,000 to fund medium-sized projects; and provided further, that the sum of \$5,000,000 under this section may be reallocated between small and medium-sized grant funds as necessary after an application and review period.

Section 2.

2.a. Grant applicants shall apply for funding through the online Barnstable County ARPA Portal and grant recipients shall expend any funds received only for the purposes and in the ways set forth in the United States Department of the Treasury Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds Final Rule (ARPA Final Rule) effective on April 1, 2022 or any subsequent directives.


2.b. A list of grant applicants and final project scoring using the project evaluation metrics shall be made available to the Assembly of Delegates and thereby the public after the completion of the application and review period.
