

The Barnstable County Registry of Deeds will re-open for in-building public access on June 1, 2021. Please be advised of the following:

Attorneys/Title Examiners/General Public:

- **We look forward to seeing you, however, due to the volume of business and our present staffing levels we would encourage attorneys to continue to e-file.**
- **A queue system will be in place for in-person recordings integrated with e-file submissions. In other words, if there are 10 e-file submissions in the queue when you arrive to record you will be #11 in the queue for recording. At busy times the queue will also apply for copy purchases and general information requests.**
- **Land Court filings need to be in the queue by 3:30 pm. If your documents are determined to be non-recordable as presented, you will have to re-enter the queue.**
- **Due to the volume of business and our present staffing levels you are urged to submit your recordings (e-file or in-person) to us as early in the day as possible. We would appreciate it greatly if you would limit your non-time sensitive recordings to the morning hours on our busiest days, which are typically Fridays and the first and last business day of the month.**
- **There are no closing tables available in the building**
- **Please keep in mind that you are subject to security rules imposed by the Court System when you enter the building.**
